information. The Organisation will appoint a Privacy Officer who will be responsible for storing, correcting and giving people access to personal information collected about them. The

Organisation may charge fees for access to personal information.

7. Personal information collected by the Organisation may be sensitive information for the purpose

of the NPPs (e.g. information about a person's religious beliefs). As a non-profit organisation, the Organisation is permitted to collect sensitive information without a person's express consent. However, the Organisation will endeavour to seek consent from a person if sensitive

information is sought for something other than the primary functions of the Organisation

described in paragraph 3.

8. The operating procedures (whether or not they are formalised in a manual) of the Organisation

will comply with this policy and the NPPs.

9. The Organisation will appoint a Privacy Officer who will be empowered to receive and deal with

any complaint that the Organisation has not complied with this policy or the NPP's.
