Epping Uniting Church (UC) is seeking a full-time chaplain to join the team at the Macquarie University, North Ryde. Reporting to the Epping Uniting Church Minister, this role will work closely with the Uniting Church University Mission Worker.

Key Responsibilities

- Providing pastoral leadership in the building of relationships with students/staff on campus, Epping UC and in the Ryde zone of Sydney Central Coast(SCC) Presbytery, as well as those who are connected with, or sympathetic, to the ethos of the Uniting Church
- Enabling the building of relationships, on behalf of the Uniting Church Chaplaincy Team and Epping UC, with leaders and members of other groups on campus and in the Ryde zone of SCC Presbytery
- Facilitating and supporting the building of relationships, on behalf of the Uniting Church Chaplaincy Team and Epping UC, with leaders of local Uniting Church Congregations, agencies and schools as appropriate
- Working as part of the Uniting Church Chaplaincy Team on a variety of wider Christian Student Union (CSU) and Macquarie University activities and events
- Supporting mission work with Epping UC and Ryde zone of SCC Presbytery to enhance community connections between individuals, groups and organisations
- Assisting in the development of new and creative opportunities for mission and discipleship that build community and authentic faith in a culturally diverse population in the Ryde zone of SCC Presbytery

- Must hold or be willing to hold a valid Working with Children Check (NSW)
